Objectives:

Practice:

In the wake of a COVID-19 pandemic which has engulfed the present day education system, we

were unable to conduct various activities on ground that are addressed to rising problems of modern society. The institute, in collaboration with Umang Geetai College of Women's Education, Nagpur, had organized an 'Online Moral Value Enrichment Certificate Course'. In this, 30 lectures had been delivered by the renowned faculties and social activists on different moral values. These lectures concentrate on the development of the student focusing on areas like happiness, humanity, cooperation, honesty, simplicity, love, unity, peace, environmental awareness etc.

Evidence of success:

292 students completed the course and they appeared for the assessment test. A formal feedback was submitted by them regarding the course, faculties, course content etc. 245 students have passed the test and were awarded with a certificate. Problem Encountered/ Resources Required:

1. Due to Online mode, students have faced network issues. The few technical barriers were faced but eventually we overcome them with the assistant of technical support team.
2. The course was organised in collaboration of the two colleges. The schedule of both colleges was different, hence instead of live sessions the whole course was conducted with recorded sessions, a replica of a MOOC course. Two WhatsApp groups were created for the discussion forum to answer the queries of the participants.

Context:

During lockdown, everyone around us were in a strange kind of depression and anxious. The uncertainty, fear and ignorance of the situation needed to be addressed. The college tried its best to share the responsibility and had organised a long term program under the title of 'Mission Fight Against Covid-19'.

Practice:

From the beginning Loknayak Bapuji Aney Mahila Mahavidyalaya was vigilant enough about the upcoming situation in this pandemic scenario. The institute organised a number of activities and programs at regular intervals. These activities include online awareness surveys, different quiz competitions, guest lectures, online certificate courses etc.

Online covid awareness drive was launched and 16 students participated in it as well as Online poster painting competition was organised.

An online quiz competition was organised on the general knowledge of the covid-19 virus. More than 200 students participated in this open online quiz.

The aim of these competitions was to raise awareness and update people regarding covid-19 and break the myths surrounding the real information. The quiz met its all desired aims and was widely received by people. The preventive measures for covid-19 were also extended to them. We circulated a PDF on 'how to be in home isolation' amongst students and society. After the first wave of covid, all of us were in a confused state, especially students. So, we organised a seminar on "Post Covid Opportunities to Students" by Dr. Richa Joseph, Mascot. A survey to judge the impact of covid 19 was organised by IQAC.

Our institute also organised a vaccination awareness campaign and a special campaign to create awareness about deadly disease mucormycosis in the second wave of covid.
